Village Hall Drainage Completed



Several issues ago, it was noted in this newsletter that there was standing water under the Village Hall and that the water was not flowing past the Hall from the street into the Preserve. County Commissioner Dave Eggers, noted this problem and brought it to the attention of the County. It was observed that if the drainage swale on the west side of the Hall was cleared out that the problem of standing water under the Hall would be corrected.

The County Public Works Department agreed to take on this project. This was a project that involved considerable planning and a number of permits. To allow the County to perform the work, OVIS agreed to an easement that permitted drainage work and would connect the drainage to the Preserve system which is adjacent to the Hall.

Once the permits had been obtained for the work, the County had to wait on the active eagles nest that is contained within the Ozona Preserve. Once the eagles left their nest in May, the work began and was recently completed. There is now a good drainage system running from Bay Street around the Hall and into the Preserve. More importantly, there is no longer any standing water underneath the Hall.

OVIS would like to thank the County Works Department and County Commissioner David Eggers for their responsiveness on this important project for our community.

Community Cleanup - Saturday, November 4

Mark your calendars for Saturday, November 4. That is the date for the next community cleanup in Ozona. This will give us a chance to clean the community up after Halloween trick-or-treating.

OVIS sponsors two cleanups in the community each year. One is done in May and the second is done in the Fall. Bob Fortner and Dave Ennis chair this effort and have done this for several years.

On that Saturday, people will meet at the Village Hall at 8:30 in the morning to get started. People are encouraged to bring their golf carts since that does facilitate the moving around to destinations where cleaning is needed. At the Hall, assignments are made along the various streets and the teams are sent out to do their work. Usually, this effort does not take much more than an hour to an hour and a half. We will have some coffee at the Hall to start things off so everyone will have plenty of energy to start the day.

We invite you to join us at the Hall, Saturday, November 4 to help us keep our community clean. All ages are welcome.

Beginning Membership and Sponsorship Drive

Ozona Village Improvement Society (OVIS) functions primarily from funds obtained through membership dues and sponsorships. OVIS membership is \$20 annually and a sponsor donation is \$100 annually. Contractor Repairs Village Hall

Earlier this year, it was discovered that one of the main beams under the Hall providing support had deteriorated and was in need of replacement. The situation had come to light during the Eagle Scout Hall improvement project. OVIS was able to find an excellent contractor who was able to do the work within the budget that OVIS had available.

The general contractor's name is Matthew Tiernan and he lives in Ozona. Matt was able to replace a section of the support beam and do structural support work related to that beam to make the foundation of the Hall secure.

As part of this project, he was able to replace or more significantly retrofit the side door of the Hall to be a normal size. The door had always been a

problem because the door opening was smaller than normal and therefore the door installed would always have to have part of its frame cut away, making it a somewhat frail door.

By modifying the window above the door, Matt was able to install a normal size door. Also, Matt replaced the stairway to the side door which was necessary because that is the location of where the beam repair was done.

Finally, Matt replaced the wall siding at that location and repainted the back or south side of the Hall. OVIS is very pleased with his work and his craftsmanship and he was a good contractor to work with. He is now being recognized as an OVIS sponsor with his card included in this newsletter.

Next Large Item Trash Pickup Is October 18

OVIS has an agreement with Waste Connections of Florida, which is one of the companies that provide trash pickup in the Ozona community. In addition to providing a discounted rate to those households that are members of the Ozona Village Improvement Society, the company also provides a special pickup of large trash items on select days for its customers.

The company performs two pickups annually. The first was in May and the second is set for Wednesday, October 18. This is an opportunity to get rid of those larger items that are in your garage or possibly yard which require some special arrangements to dispose of.

There are a few ground rules for the pickup. Included are furniture, appliances and items such as that, but it does not include roofing materials, hazardous materials, tires or other car parts. Also refrigerators and air conditioning units must be tagged by a licensed repair man that freon has been removed. Brush has to be tied in bundles of 50 pounds or less and no longer than four feet. It would be a good idea to place items in front of your property the evening before. Remember, you must be a Waste Connections of Florida customer.

Trash Collections Options in Ozona

One of the benefits of being a member of the Ozona Village Improvement Society is that Waste Connections of Florida gives a discount to OVIS members.

To better understand that benefit, OVIS Treasurer Jim Wiesner did a survey of the companies that provide trash collection in Ozona. The survey results of the various trash services quarterly costs include the comparative pricing for twice per week pick-up (6-8 cans per pick-up) including recycling.

Of course, some of the trash services either don't have a large garbage receptacles or charge for the receptacles, but Waste Connections of Florida doesn't charge for the containers.

Below are the quarterly pricing, which gives the OVIS discount ranging between \$134-\$206 per year savings compared to other trash collection services in the area with the exception of Superior Trash Service, where the savings is at least \$80 per year (pricing quoted in August 2017).

*Waste Connection of Florida - \$52 (\$74.00 without OVIS membership discount = \$25.48 per quarter *decrease* from 2016)

Waste Management - \$100.88 (\$7.88 per quarter *increase* from 2016 and fluctuates based upon fuel charges)

Waste Pro - \$103.53 (same price as 2016, and fluctuates based upon fuel charges)

Solar Sanitation - \$99 (\$4.50 per quarter *increase* from 2016)

DisposAll - \$85.50 (.30 per quarter *decrease* from 2016)

Superior Trash Service - \$71.85 (no garbage

receptacle or recycling; 3 can maximum - same price as 2016)

The comparison shows that Waste Connections of Florida is the overall best priced option for residential trash collection as an OVIS member.

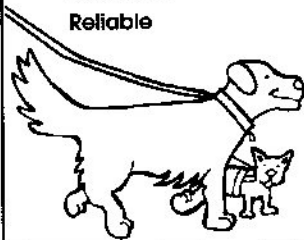

Taking A Ride on the Pinellas Trail

For those in the community that are interested in a long ride or a different ride or walk on the Pinellas Trail, there are new opportunities.

This past July, five miles were added to the Trail, extending east on Keystone Road across East Lake Road with a connection to the Brooker Creek Preserve Education Center and also with a segment going north through the Preserve's natural environment area to the Pasco County line. That segment is part of the emerging Coast-to-Coast Trail that will eventually tie the Pinellas Trail to the Cape Canaveral area by trail!

In 2018, this trail segment will be extended two and half miles into Pasco County, connecting to the existing Trail network there. Once that is done, you will be able to take your bike all the way to the north end of the Suncoast Parkway Trail in Hernando County.

And, a little closer to home, this year there will be a park trail constructed within the Honeymoon Island State Park that will connect to the Trail on the Dunedin Causeway. This is an important safety initiative because as people proceed from the Causeway Trail into the Park, they have to currently use the Park Road mixed with the cars. This new Trail would provide a much safer option. So stay tuned for that one!

The Village Hall in Ozona is located on Bay Street and has served as the facility for community events over the years. The Hall is owned by the Ozona Village Improvement Society (OVIS) which uses the Hall for community events and meetings during the year.

In addition to that, OVIS does make the Hall available for rental for private events as well. While the Hall has a heritage and appearance of its vintage construction of 1900, the Hall does have the modern conveniences of central heat and air conditioning, restrooms and a kitchen area (without a stove).

Folding tables and chairs are also included in the Hall rental. The Hall rents for \$300 for a private event. If someone is an OVIS member, there is a reduced rate of \$250. If you wish to rent the Hall, the contact information is available above or on the OVIS website.

Why Get A Post Office Box

Ozona is zip code 34660. As people know who have been around a while, your mailing address will not reflect Ozona unless you use that zip code. The only way you can use the zip code is by having an Ozona PO Box.

When you first get a post office box, you may view it as somewhat inconvenient to go and get the mail versus having it delivered to your door. However, there have been benefits added to this service over the years. First of all, you don't have to deal with the mail until you get it. They also have a procedure where your local postmaster can sign for those boxes that are normally either left at your doorstep or that you must go to a location to pick up. This applies to any kind of box or package. When you go on vacation or leave town for a while, the mail is stored in the post office and you get it when you return. There is, of course, the benefit of meeting people in the community as you go to get your mail.

Another benefit is the fact that you can list Ozona as your mailing address. That is a BIG plus! We are lucky to have a local post office with Linda in charge. She is a very service oriented manager.

If these points make sense to you, you might want to swing by the Ozona Post Office and talk with Linda or Rob. You can rent a box in various sizes.

Sheriff's Neighborhood Watch Workshop

Ozona has an established Neighborhood Watch Program that is operated as an outreach program by the Sheriff's Office. Dolly Swallow is the Ozona community contact for this education and informational program. Through this outreach, the community is made aware of things to look out for in order to keep the community safe. OVIS hosts a workshop each year where a representative from the Sheriff's Office comes to the Hall and reviews how people can be informed and participate. This year's workshop is set for Monday, January 22. Deputy Skipper will present the program and then be available for questions and comments from people in attendance.

The regular meeting of OVIS is scheduled for 7:00 p.m. that evening with the neighborhood workshop being the main topic. This is always a very informative program and one that is important to ensure that our community continues to be a safe place.

Everyone is encouraged to attend this workshop. There will be a reminder in the next newsletter. If you cannot attend and would like to be part of the neighborhood watch email list, you may contact Dolly at dollys@winntech.net.

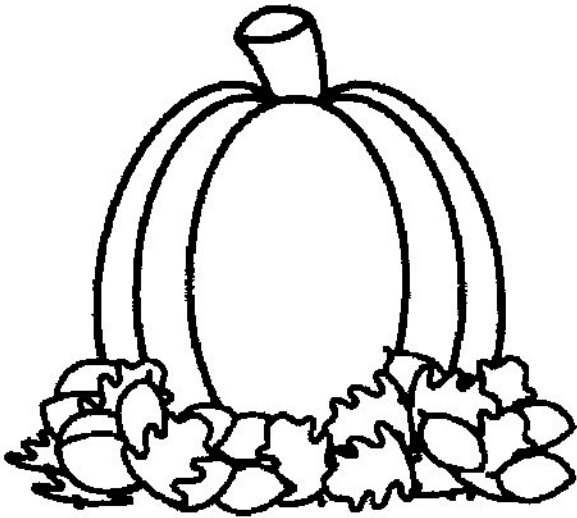
