OVIS Annual Meeting Set For May 6

The Annual Meeting of OVIS is set for May 6 at 7 PM at the Village Hall. The meeting will include an election of officers for the coming year along with an update on several subjects of interest to the community. Everyone in the community is welcome to attend. A meeting agenda will be distributed a week before the meeting.

Tree Planting Update

This past year OVIS initiated a community tree planting program with 25 trees planted in several installations in Ozona. That program was successful with a lot of participation in the community. There was a challenge with respect to the drought at the time, but most of the trees survived that situation.

This is intended to be an annual effort, and therefore, discussions are being renewed for a second year. This effort will be designed around what was learned from the first year. The intention is that this program will replace and preserve some of the tree canopy that is so well-recognized in Ozona. Needless to say, this is an on-going challenge, but with the support of the community, we will continue to be successful!

Alt US-19 Roundabout Update

The roundabout on Alternate US-19 at Florida Avenue is undergoing some beautification improvements. It should be noted that this is a Florida Department of Transportation project that is being done in cooperation with Pinellas County. Palm trees have been added, along with some other landscaping, to improve the appearance of this facility. And they have been installed in a way, where there will not be any visibility problems. The struts supporting the palm trees are a temporary feature that will be removed once the trees are established. This is a signature, aesthetic improvement and is intended to provide a calming atmosphere for the drivers maneuvering through the facility.

Shore Drive Bridge Replacement

Approximately a year ago on April 18, 2023, Pinellas County held an information meeting on a replacement of the Shore Drive Bridge in Ozona. The bridge was originally built in 1923 and has been in continuous operation since then for over 100 years. It has been a year since that information meeting, and Pinellas County has been filling in the details of the final design that was presented to the community at that meeting. Since construction is scheduled to begin in early 2025, it would be useful to briefly review the design and schedule for this important facility.

The new bridge will be a significant improvement over the existing design. The current facility has substandard 10-foot wide lanes in each direction, and no provision for pedestrians. The new design will have 11-foot lanes with shoulders and a 6 foot wide sidewalk on the southside.

Another new feature would be that the sidewalk would extend from the bridge east to Orange Street, which is a significant pedestrian safety feature.

This past year has seen a lot of activity in our community. The most significant one was the resurfacing of the roads within Ozona. This was a much-needed project and was accomplished efficiently by Pinellas County. We also Initiated our Tree Canopy Program for the community. Village Hall Improvements

The Board of County Commissioners has approved an MSTU grant to fund some improvements to the Ozona Village Hall. On the inside of the hall, the floors will be refinished. This work will include some repairs. There is a section on the floor, where there is wood rot damage that will be replaced. It is amazing that this is the original flooring installed in the hall in 1900.

On the outside of the hall, the hall will be repainted. Some sections that have shown the wear of time will be replaced. This siding work will be in accordance with historic protocols for the design and replacement materials.

This work will take several weeks, and OVIS will work around any scheduled hall rentals. The total project cost will be \$18,782.50.

Ozona Holiday Golf Cart Parade Update

The Village Hall in Ozona is located on Bay Street and has served as the facility for community events over the years. The Hall is owned by the Ozona Village Improvement Society (OVIS), which uses the Hall for community events and meetings during the year.

In addition to that, OVIS does make the Hall available for rental for private events as well. While the Hall has a heritage and appearance of its vintage construction of 1900, the Hall does have the modern conveniences of central heat and air conditioning, restrooms, and a kitchen area (without a stove).

Folding tables and chairs are also included in the Hall rental. The Hall rents for \$500 for a private event. If someone is an OVIS member, there is a reduced rate of \$250. OVIS Membership and Sponsorship







