# The Resurfacing of Orange Street and Tampa Road

Orange Street and Tampa Road are the main arteries in Ozona. They receive a lot of traffic and as a result are showing a lot of wear. That will soon change. The County has scheduled a resurfacing project for both roads for early next year.

When the County does such a project, they usually work with the utility agencies so that they have an opportunity to upgrade any facilities before the road work has begun. That is why we have seen a lot of utility work over the past few months. Since both of these roads are two lanes with one lane in each direction, the construction will be phased. The County will keep one lane open while the other lane is being resurfaced. We have already received a taste of this procedure with the utilities work.

The County indicates that part of the project may take a week or two, so we need to be prepared to allow extra time on our trips when this phase of the project is going on. The project is anticipated to begin in late March or early April. The resurfacing of Orange Street will begin at Alternate US 19 and proceed north with a termination at Pennsylvania Avenue. Tampa Road resurfacing will begin at Orange Street on the west and proceed out of our community across Alternate US 19 terminating at County Road One. When the project is complete there will be no more potholes, and the shoulder of the roads will be more friendly.

Since the project is in the early stages, more information may become available. Therefore, as this information becomes available, OVIS will include that in upcoming newsletters or through special announcements.

## **Living Shoreline Update**

The Living Shoreline Project event at the end of Bay Street was a major success. This is the first living shoreline project for Pinellas County. It was unique not only in its design and purpose but also with its inclusion of volunteers. The project event on the morning of September 19 included 30 community volunteers, 4 Marine Discovery staff and volunteers, 5 County staff and one Tampa Bay Watch staff.

The project included 350 oyster bags and planted two different types of marsh grass – 90 cordgrass and 90 needle rush. Stacey Day, the County person responsible for the project, says that a few more plants may be added in the Spring to replace those that did not make it. The Shuck and Share program has a great website with information about the oyster bags that were installed. That website is <a href="http://shuckandshare.org">http://shuckandshare.org</a>.

Signs describing the shoreline project are being installed on the railing above the project on Bay Street. Stacey says this is the first demonstration project that the County has installed as part of a larger initiative to promote living elements in front of seawalls and along the coast to protect against rising seas and stronger storms. Also, it makes the shoreline healthier and more attractive.

## **Pinellas Trail Use Increases**



During this pandemic period, use of the Pinellas Trail has doubled. The estimated number is 250,000 for the highest month for the St. Petersburg to Tarpon Springs section. Another interesting fact is the fact that 90% of the people on the trail are riding bikes. A couple of years ago it was more evenly split between pedestrians and bicycles.

## **Golf Carts Now Allowed In Old Palm Harbor**

The County Commission has now authorized golf carts in the Old Palm Harbor area. The general boundaries of the area are Delaware Street on the north, 16th Street on the east, Virginia Street on the south, and Alternate US 19 on the west.

The compliance rules are basically the same as those in place in Ozona. A golf cart crossing for Alternate US 19 from and to Ozona is being permitted at Georgia Street with signs recognizing that and are in the process of being installed now.

It should be noted that the existing golf cart ordinance permits golf carts in Ozona and Crystal Beach west of Alternate US 19. This will increase the destinations for the people in Ozona. The challenge will be to take care when crossing Alternate US 19.

# **OVIS Membership and Sponsorship**

Ozona Village Improvement Society (OVIS) functions primarily from funds obtained through membership dues and sponsorships. OVIS membership is \$20 annually and a sponsor donation is \$100 annually. It is noted that if you are a Waste Connections' customer you will receive a discount if you have an OVIS membership. 


