Ozona Annual Holiday Golf Cart Parade

Our traditional holiday golf cart parade in Ozona is set to go Sunday, December 10. This will be the 22nd year that we have had this parade. The first parade had five golf carts in it, and now for the past few years we have had over 100 participating. With this large number of carts participating, it has become necessary for our community to formally organize this event. That means that a permit is needed. OVIS agreed to be the sponsor for this event, and to handle the various administrative functions connected with such a permit. Event insurance was required and obtained. Also, an agreement with the Sheriff's Office for traffic management was put in place.

Over the years, not only has the event improved in its function, but the golf carts have as well. In the beginning, the golf carts were limited in the decorations as the focus of the cart was basic transportation on the golf course. However, now there are retrofit packages available for people to upgrade their golf cart electrical system to handle this new décor functioning. This has opened the door for some elaborate decorations.

The gathering area for the parade is the section of Orange Street between Tampa Road and Bay Street. This area functions as a community center because it contains the Post Office and some community restaurants. There is a graphic in this newsletter that defines the route of the parade. Participation in the parade requires that the golf cart be registered with OVIS, and there is a separate article about how to participate, which is included in this newsletter.

The parade officially starts at 6 PM with a Sheriff's vehicle with its lights on, heading north on Orange Street. It has become a tradition also that County Commissioner Dave Eggers participates by riding in this Sheriff's vehicle. The parade participants with their carts then follow. Another Sheriff's vehicle is at the end of the parade. This parade has become a premier event for the Ozona community and is enjoyed by not only the residents of Ozona, but our many visitors as well.

We are looking forward to seeing everyone and all the decorated carts on Sunday, December 10!

Community Potluck — Tuesday, December 12

The traditional Ozona Community Potluck gathering at the Village Hall is set for Tuesday, December 12. This is a time when people gather at the Hall in recognition of the holidays. A potluck dinner is an old tradition where people gather together bringing food they have prepared or have obtained, and then share this food with others during conversation and networking. In Ozona we also have restaurants as neighbors. They, too, participate in this Potluck, providing some selection from their menu. This does make the Potluck unique for Ozona.

The Hall will be decorated for the holidays and the potluck will begin at 6 PM. Everyone in the community is invited to participate and to bring guests, if you have them. In addition to food, there will be beverages (wine, beer, water and soft drinks), or you can bring your own brand! So, come join your neighbors, network, and get caught up on what is happening in your community.

Resurfacing the Streets of Ozona

The County has just completed the resurfacing project of the community roads within Ozona. Considering the magnitude of this project, it went very smoothly and had limited impact on the community and our daily functioning. This was a follow-up to an earlier resurfacing project, where the County did improvements on the collector roads, which included Orange Street, Tampa Road, and Pennsylvania Avenue. This was a much needed project and very well done. Now we shouldn't have to deal with potholes for many years.



Community Tree Program

This past summer the community initiated its first tree planting effort. This included 25 large trees being planted in strategic places as part of a tree canopy concept. There have been some challenges with this, because of the very dry weather we have had. People in the community have been encouraged to water these trees. Three locations where the trees have been planted are: Pennsylvania Avenue (between the church and the school); Orange Street on the south west corner of Pennsylvania Avenue, and in the Pinellas Trail area south of Florida Avenue and Orange Street. With that said, OVIS plans to continue sponsoring this program because there is a considerable interest in the community in this mission. A section has been added to the OVIS website (www.OzonaVillageFL.us/fundraisers) to give people an opportunity to donate to this tree canopy program. This will be an ongoing program and once enough money has been accumulated in this fund, then another round of tree planting will be scheduled.

Village Hall Improvements to be Considered

The Ozona Village Hall is one of the oldest buildings in the County. It was built by the community in 1889 with donated labor and materials. The following year, in 1900, OVIS was established to own and operate the Hall. As with any structure, care is needed to maintain the building, especially considering its age. With that said, OVIS will be seeking a community grant with the County to make some needed improvements under the heading of maintenance. These improvements are expected to include refurbishment of the hall floor and painting the exterior of the hall. Care will be taken to schedule this work around the renting of the hall for events.

OVIS Membership and Sponsorship

Ozona Village Improvement Society (OVIS) functions primarily from funds obtained through membership dues and sponsorships. OVIS membership is \$20 annually and a sponsor donation is \$100 annually. It is noted that if you are a Waste Connections' customer you will receive a discount if you have an OVIS membership. Also, if you are an OVIS sponsor, your business card is included in the newsletter and on the community website.

The membership and sponsorship run from January 1 to December 31, but OVIS begins open enrollment in September to allow for the logistics of the program. It should be noted, however, that membership or sponsorship actually start from the time of enrollment (there is no delayed effective date). The last page of the newsletter is devoted to an enrollment form, or you can go to the OVIS website and enroll or renew there using PayPal. The website is http://www.ozonavillagefl.us/membership.



Holiday Golf Cart Parade Details

Here are some specifics about the parade. This year's registration donation fee is \$20.00. You can purchase the registration fee online at https://www.ozonavillagefl.us/annual-ozona-holiday-parade or by scanning the QR code below.

We are asking that if you want to participate in the prize contest for the best decorated golf cart, then you will need to register online. If you register and pay at the time of the event, then you will not be eligible for the best golf cart contest. Also, if you pay online, it will only cost \$20.00, but if you pay at the event, it will cost \$30.00. Online registration is currently open and allowed until Thursday, December 7, 2023. You can pay online with PayPal along with your registration, or you can pay in person to Donna Green at Green and Associates Real Estate at 410 North Orange Street in Ozona. In-person payments can be made Monday thru Friday during their normal business hours and will only be accepted until Thursday, December 7, 2023. Once your payment has been confirmed, then the OVIS Village Treasurer will send you a PDF of your registered Golf Cart Number, which you will need to print out and attach visibly to the front of your golf cart for the event. Your Golf Cart Number is not only needed to show your registration for the event but also for the judging process for the best golf cart contest. *Be sure to complete the entire parade route and return to the Downtown Ozona area to receive your trophy and any related prizes!* Any questions, inquiries or follow-up on registration confirmation can be addressed to the OVIS Village Treasurer at james.wiesner@yahoo.com.

The golf carts should come to the start / gathering area around Molly Goodhead's and the Ozona Pig (designated by the large Red Star on the map), where they will prepare to get into position for the parade line-up. Golf carts should be there by 5:30 PM, and the parade will start promptly at 6:00 PM. Please go to the area between Molly's Goodheads and the US Post Office to register golf carts for the parade, if you have not done so online beforehand. A judges table with trophies will be set up along that corridor to register.

In addition to that, OVIS does make the Hall available for rental for private events as well. While the Hall has a heritage and appearance of its vintage construction of 1900, the Hall does have the modern conveniences of central heat and air conditioning, restrooms, and a kitchen area (without a stove).

Folding tables and chairs are also included in the Hall rental. The Hall rents for \$500 for a private event. If someone is an OVIS member, there is a reduced rate of \$250. 
